**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-1207FDG**

**An Ordinance abating  
The tax heretofore levied for the year 2021  
To pay debt service on \$3,100,000  
General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source)  
Of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees (the “Board”) of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois (the “Issuer”), by ordinance adopted on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2017, (the “Ordinance”), did provide for the issue of \$3,100,000 General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source) (the “Bonds”), and the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to pay principal and interest on the Bonds; and

**WHEREAS**, the issuer will have Pledged Revenues (as defined in the Ordinance) available for the purpose of paying the debt service due on the Bonds during the next succeeding bond year; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary and in the best interests of the Issuer that the tax heretofore levied for the year 2021 to pay such debt service be abated:

**NOW, THEREFORE**, Be It and It is Hereby Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1:      Abatement of Tax. The tax heretofore levied for the year 2021 in the Ordinance is hereby abated in its entirety.

Section 2:      Filing of Ordinance. Forthwith upon the adoption of this ordinance, the Village Clerk shall file a certified copy hereof with the County Clerk of Kane County, Illinois, and it shall be the duty of said County Clerk to abate said tax levied for the year 2021 in accordance with the provisions hereof.

Section 3:      Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.
