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**ISSUE**

Should the Village approve an ordinance amending the Village Code Section 3-2-6 License Classifications - Class C – Temporary.

**DISCUSSION**

At the July 7, 2022 Special Village Board meeting, the Board passed an ordinance amending Village Code Section 3-2-6 License Classifications – Class C – Temporary removing the provision that license holders must be non-for-profit organizations. Prior to the change, the Village had been contacted by Catering by Michaels regarding selling liquor at the LIV Golf Event at Rich Harvest Farms this summer. This change opened up the license for for-profit businesses to apply for temporary permits.

During the board meeting, it was noted that the ordinance may need to be amended again to accommodate liquor sales of greater than six percent (6%) of alcohol by weight. Staff spoke with Catering by Michaels following their trip to view the LIV Golf Event in Portland and they indicated they would be like to offer for sale alcohol greater than 6%. The attached ordinance removes the provision restricting the amount of alcohol by weight and also the provision that the permit only applies to municipally or other governmentally owned property.

**COST**

There are small costs to codify the ordinance, which are already included in the budget.

**RECOMMENDATION**

That the Village Board approve an ordinance amending the Village Code Section 3-2-6 License Classifications - Class C – Temporary.

**An Ordinance Amending Village Code Section 3-2-6-3 (Liquor License Classifications – Temporary)**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois, as follows;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Sugar Grove is not a home rule municipality within Article VII, Section 6A of the Illinois Constitution and accordingly, acts pursuant to the powers granted to it under 65 ILCS 5/1-1 et seq.; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Liquor Control Act, 235 ILCS 5/4-1, establishes that the Village of Sugar Grove Board of Trustees shall have the power by general ordinance or resolution to determine the number, kind, and classification of licenses, for sale at retail of alcoholic liquor; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Sugar Grove Board of Trustees finds that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the Village of Sugar Grove to amend the Village of Sugar Grove Village Code Section 3-2-6-C with regard to temporary licenses.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION ONE: TEXT AMENDMENTS**

**Section 3-2-6-C (License Classifications - Temporary) of the Village Code shall be amended to read as follows:**

**3-2-6-C. Class C - Temporary**

- a. A class C license authorizes the licensee to sell alcoholic liquor to be consumed on the premises where sold and not for resale in any form at a banquet, picnic, bazaar, fair, celebration, or similar private or public assembly ~~and not containing more than six percent (6%) of alcohol by weight.~~
- b. ~~Such license authorizes the retail sale and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages containing not more than six percent (6%) alcohol on municipally or other governmentally owned property.~~ The boundaries of the licensed premises and the duration of the license shall be established by the local liquor commissioner. The licensee shall maintain the premises in a neat, orderly and safe condition, shall provide such traffic control and sanitation facilities to protect the public health, safety, welfare and morals of the residents of the village, and shall restore premises after expiration of the license to its prior condition, including the removal of trash, rubbish and garbage. No alcoholic liquor shall be brought onto the premises or consumed on the premises other than that provided by the licensee under the terms and conditions of this chapter.
- c. The license issued shall be limited to the premises specified in the license.

- d. Payment shall be made to the village for the actual costs incurred by the village in providing additional police personnel necessitated by improper conduct or control by the licensee on the specific premises. Each licensee who is to be held responsible for additional charges shall receive an itemized invoice therefor, shall be given an opportunity to review the charges with the liquor control commissioner, and shall thereafter promptly pay any such additional charge determined by the commissioner to be due the village.
- e. Such license shall be authorized on a day to day basis, but for not more than five (5) consecutive days.

## **SECTION TWO: GENERAL PROVISIONS**

**REPEALER:** All ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SEVERABILITY:** Should any portion of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction; the remaining provisions will remain in full force and effect the same as if the invalid provision had not been a part of this Ordinance.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its approval, passage, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
