WHEREAS, Leah was recognized as the 2018 SportsKid of the Year by Sports Illustrated Kids, and

**WHEREAS**, Leah has achieved numerous Illinois Swimming Age Group Records, two Illinois High School Association State Records, eight National Age Group Records, and recently one World Junior Record becoming the fastest woman (under 18) for the 200M IM in world history.

**WHEREAS**, in April 2022, Leah participated in the 2022 Phillips 66 International Team Trials finishing 2nd in the 200M IM with a National Age Group record time of 2:09.99, and

WHEREAS, her 2nd place finish qualified Leah to represent Team USA at the 2022 FINA World Championships this past July in Budapest, Hungary, where she went on to win the Bronze Medal, and
