#### ISSUE

Shall the Village authorize the execution of a 3-year agreement with Lauterbach & Amen for Actuarial Study Services for the Police Pension Fund for Fiscal Year 2023, 2024 and 2025.

#### DISCUSSION

The current engagement letter with Lauterbach & Amen has expired with the Actuarial Study completed for FYE April 30, 2022. The Village requested a renewal 3-year proposal from Lauterbach & Amen. The proposal includes completion of the Police Funding Actuarial Valuation and Police GASB 67/68 Actuarial Valuation:

The final year of the engagement letter had a total cost of \$5,500 for the full Police Pension Fund Actuarial Study. The increase proposed is 4.5% annually, or \$250 in year one, \$260 in year two and \$270 in year three.

Even though the Police Pension Fund has consolidated to a downstate Pension Fund, the local Police Pension Fund is still required to complete an actuarial study for two main reasons:

- 1. The Consolidated Pension Fund will not be providing the GASB 67/68 Financial Reporting portions of the Actuarial which are required for the Village's annual audit.
- 2. The Consolidated Pension Fund actuarial study that will be completed only provides one funding level, 90% EAN. While this is statutorily the only amount they are required to

provide, this leaves local governments in a position to have a separate Actuarial Study completed to determine the 100% EAN funding level, as to not continue to increase the unfunded liability.

# COST

The cost of the FY2023 Police Pension Actuarial Study would be \$5,750, which would be budgeted for in the FY2024 budget.

You will not be charged any additional costs under this section unless written approval, including email confirmation, is provided ahead of time.

In connection with this agreement, the Village of Sugar Grove authorizes Lauterbach & Amen, LLP to automatically debit the Village's disbursement account at BMO Harris Bank N.A. upon completion of any past, present, or future services for the cost agreed upon in the respective engagement letter. Either the Village or Lauterbach & Amen, LLP may terminate this auto debit arrangement at any time by providing prior written notice to the other.

Either party may terminate all or a portion of the services contemplated by this engagement at any time for any reason upon 30 days written notice to the other. Subcontracting will be disclosed to the Village's Board of Trustees prior to beginning work. This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.
