ISSUE

Shall the Village Board approve an Ordinance amending the Village Code Title 6 as it pertains to truck parking in residential areas in the Village.

DISCUSSION

At the last meeting of the Village Board, truck parking in residential areas was discussed at length. The Board was sympathetic to residents who have the need to bring work vehicles home for overnight parking and was determined to find a way to provide easily understood and enforceable regulations to keep out the unwanted truck vehicle types and permit less egregious truck types to park on residential property.

In the end the Village Board opted to use a blend of Secretary of State license plate classifications and truck types to delineate permitted and non-permitted truck types and directed Village staff to prepare an Ordinance memorializing this decision. The attached Ordinance amends the Village Code, Title 6 pertaining to truck parking in residential areas. Title 11, Zoning Regulations, also will need to be similarly amended, but the requisite public hearing will not be held until March 15, 2023. An Ordinance amending the zoning regulations will be presented to the Village Board for consideration at a future date.

6-3-8-B: VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS/STORAGE OF VEHICLES:

7. Buses And Trucks: All parking and/or storage of vehicles requiring more than a Class ~~DH~~ license plate, or apportioned, tow truck, or trailer plates, as established by the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Illinois such as step vans, box trucks, semi-tractors, dump trucks, crane truck, tank trucks, buses, ~~trucks, tractors, and trailers~~ on residential property is prohibited; however, the parking of a school bus, as defined by 625 Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/1-182, shall not be prohibited between eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. and four o'clock (4:00) P.M., provided:
 - a. The occupant of the residential property is the authorized driver of said school bus; and
 - b. The school bus is parked no closer than fifteen feet (15') from the sidewalk adjacent to said residential property or, where no sidewalk exists, no closer than fifteen feet (15') from the street adjacent to said residential property;

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE TITLE 6, REGULATIONS
(TRUCK PARKING IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Sugar Grove (the “Village”) is not a home rule municipality within Article VII, Section 6A of the Illinois Constitution and, pursuant to the powers granted to it under 65 ILCS 5/1-1 *et seq.*; and,

WHEREAS, the Village seeks to continue to promote these interests, and seeks to amend the Village Code to more fully protect and preserve the safety and well-being of such inhabitants; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Village Code amendment

Title 6 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Village Code of Ordinances be amended as provided in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof by this reference.

SECTION TWO: GENERAL PROVISIONS

REPEALER: All ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions will remain in full force and effect the same as if the invalid provision had not been a part of this Ordinance.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its approval, passage and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
