WHEREAS, Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our police officers and firefighters by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information and insuring their safety; and,

WHEREAS, Public Safety Telecommunicators of Tri-Com Central Dispatch have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and,

WHEREAS, each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year;

THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of Sugar Grove proclaims the week of April 9 through 15, 2023 to be National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in the Village of Sugar Grove in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our city and citizens safe,
