RESOLUTION 20240206D

A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST A PETITION FOR A WRIT OF *QUO WARRANTO*DECLARING THE OFFICE HELD BY SEAN MICHELS AS VILLAGE TRUSTEE TO BE VACANT

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/3.1-10-50(c)(2) provides that where a Trustee enters a plea of guilty to charges of an infamous crime, such as forgery, the office held by that Trustee becomes vacant; and

WHEREAS, Sean Michels, a member of this Board holding the office of Trustee, has been charged with the offense of forgery; and

WHEREAS, said Trustee has entered into a written Agreement with the Kane County State's Attorney which includes the admission, by said Trustee, that acts constituting the elements of said charge were, in fact, committed; and

WHEREAS, a determination of whether the Agreement, signed by said Trustee and entered of record by the Circuit Court of Kane County, creates a vacancy in the office held by said Trustee, is a matter for the Court's determination upon a Petition for a Writ of *Quo Warranto*; and

WHEREAS, a *Quo Warranto* proceeding is initiated by a request addressed to the Kane County State's Attorney who has discretion to either so proceed or to decline said request; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined that the admissions made by said Trustee create serious questions regarding safeguarding the public trust that require consideration by the County's Chief Legal Officer concerning said Trustee's lawful fitness and eligibility to remain in office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the President of the Village Board is hereby authorized and directed to make a request upon the Kane County State's Attorney to petition the Court for a Writ of *Quo Warranto* declaring the office of Sean Michels to be declared vacant.
