

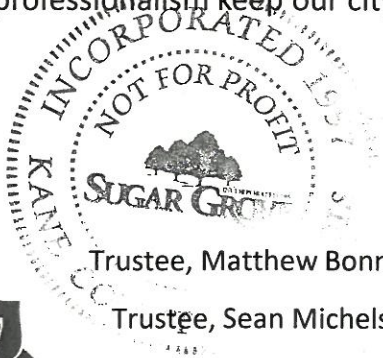


# *Proclamation*

## **National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week April 14-20, 2024**

- WHEREAS,** emergencies can occur at any time that require police, fire, or emergency medical services; and
- WHEREAS,** when an emergency occurs, the prompt response of police officers, firefighters and paramedics is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and
- WHEREAS,** the safety of our police officers and firefighters is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who telephone Tri-Com Central Dispatch, Sugar Grove's Emergency Communications Center; and
- WHEREAS,** Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and
- WHEREAS,** Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our police officers and firefighters by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information and ensuring their safety; and
- WHEREAS,** Public Safety Telecommunicators of Tri-Com Central Dispatch have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and
- WHEREAS,** each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year.

**THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED** that the Village Board of Sugar Grove proclaims the week of April 14 – 20, 2024, to be **National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week** in the Village of Sugar Grove in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our city and citizens safe.
