**SUBJECT:** ORDINANCE: AMENDING TITLE 6 CHAPTER 2 GENERAL PROVISIONS, ADDING SECTION 3, PARAGRAPH "A", STOP SIGN LOCATIONS WITHIN THE VILLAGE

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### ISSUE

Should the Village Board amend Title 6, Chapter 2, by adding Section 3, Paragraph "A" creating a list of stop signs within the Village of Sugar Grove.

### DISCUSSION

At the March 18, 2025, Village Board Meeting, staff presented a traffic study for part of Windsor Pointe Subdivision, specific to traffic concerns heard from the residents in the area. Staff and the village engineer reviewed the traffic study prior to the meeting and determined through numerous factors the need to add additional Stop Signs on some of the roadways in Windsor Pointe, based on geometrics, roadway configurations, line of sight, distance, nearby parks, public safety for pedestrians, motoring public, bicycles, etc., and traffic collection data sets. A nearby potential development and traffic impact also placed an emphasis on today's existing traffic patterns and volume of vehicles on the roadways.

Staff based on the traffic study determined that the current two-way stop sign at the intersection of Park Ave., Belle Vue Ln., Exeter Ln., and Regency Blvd, shall become a (4) four-way stop intersection. A pre-emptive warning sign should be placed on Recency Blvd at the curve alerting the public of an upcoming stop sign.

In addition, the current Yield Sign at Somerset Dr, and Hampton Rd. should be a Stop Sign with an additional sign underneath designating that "Cross Traffic Does Not Stop".

Also, the Yield Sign on Hampton Rd. and Exeter Ln, should be replaced with a Stop Sign (adjacent to a park with line of sight and pedestrian/bicycle traffic concerns).

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-0415PD-2**

**An Ordinance Amending Title 6– Chapter 2 of the Village Code of Ordinances  
General Provisions by adding Section 3, Paragraph “A” Stop Sign Location within the  
Village  
Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois, as follows;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Sugar Grove (“Village”) is not a home rule municipality within Article VII, Section 6A of the Illinois Constitution, and accordingly, seeks to act pursuant to the powers granted to it under 65 ILCS 5/1-1 *et seq.*; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village President (the “President”) and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the “Village Board” and with the President, the “Corporate Authorities”) are committed to ensuring the health and safety and welfare of the Village residents; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village operates and maintains a road network as part of its municipal function; and

**WHEREAS**, traffic control is an essential part of the operation of the road network; and

**WHEREAS**, the village ordinance regarding adding stop signs to streets is governed by the Illinois Vehicle Code, specifically 625 ILCS 5/11-30, which grants local authorities the power to designate through highways and erect stop signs, subject to certain conditions and engineering judgement; and

**WHEREAS**, currently there is a two-way stop sign for the intersection of Belle Vue Ln. and Exeter Ln. where Regency Blvd. and Park Ave. come together as an intersection; the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village and its residents and guests to install stop signs at this intersection to make it an all-way stop (4 way Stop intersection); and

**WHEREAS**, currently there is a yield sign for the intersection of Somerset Dr. at Hampton Rd., however given the traffic study conducted for Windsor Pointe, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village and its residents and guests to install stop sign at this location (in place of the Yield Sign); and

**WHEREAS**, currently there is a yield sign for the intersection of Hampton Rd. at Exeter Ln, however given the traffic study conducted for Windsor Pointe, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village and its residents and guests to install stop sign at this location (in place of the Yield Sign); and

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it ordained by the corporate authorities of the Village of Sugar Grove as follows.

**SECTION 1: TITLE 6 – CHAPTER 2 – Amend General Provisions by adding Paragraph “A” Stop Sign Locations within the Village.**

Any provision not specifically enumerated herein shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION TWO: GENERAL PROVISIONS**

REPEALER: All ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SEVERABILITY: Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction; the remaining provisions will remain in full force and effect the same as if the invalid provision had not been a part of this Ordinance.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its approval, passage and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
