ISSUE

Should the Village Board of Trustees approve a Commercial Property Enhancement Program grant application submitted by Sugar Grove American Legion Post 1271?

DISCUSSION

The Commercial Property Enhancement Program (CPEP) was approved by the Village Board in September of 2022.

At the September 2nd Village Board meeting, the board discussed the application from the American Legion. All of the Trustees agreed that they support the American Legion. The CPEP Review Committee met to discuss the application and was unanimous in recommending approval as well.

Sugar Grove American Legion Post 1271 has submitted a grant application for improvements to their parking lot in downtown Sugar Grove. The owner plans to make the following improvements: (1) tear out existing parking lot and remove debris; (2) replace parking lot with asphalt; (3) restripe parking area. Village staff met with the property owner at the site and assisted them in the application process. The total cost for the project is \$33,177.50. The applicant is requesting a \$10,000.00 CPEP grant.

The Village Board requested that the application and process be brought back for discussion at a future meeting. Economic Development Assistant Becky Gwilt gathered information, coordinated meetings, and led the CPEP review committee meeting.

COST

There is no cost for the discussion. Sugar Grove American Legion Post 1271 is requesting a CPEP grant for \$10,000.00. The FY2025-2026 Budget includes \$30,000 for the grant program.
