**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 9 OF THE VILLAGE CODE  
(ELECTRICAL CODE)**

**WHEREAS;** the Village of Sugar Grove is not a home rule municipality within Article VII, Section 6A of the Illinois Constitution and, pursuant to those powers granted to it under 65 ILCS 5/1-1 *et. seq.*; and,

**WHEREAS;** the Board of Trustees finds that the best interest of the Village of Sugar Grove and the health and welfare of the residents of the Village are best served by regulating the construction, reconstruction, and maintenance of buildings and structure with the Village,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** That Section 9-1-2-B-15 of the Village Code shall be amended to be and to read as follows:

15. Reserved.

**SECTION TWO:** Miscellaneous

A. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Village of Sugar Grove hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional.


B. Savings: That nothing in this Ordinance or in the codes hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 2 of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance


C. Repealer: All ordinance or provisions of ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

D. Effective Date: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law and after January 19, 2021.
