

2026 Spring Parkway Tree Program

The Program

As part of the Village's ongoing environmental effort, and in order to increase the number of trees in town, the Village is offering a 50/50 Cost Sharing Program for parkway trees. The Village will contribute 50% of the cost of the trees, with residents providing the remaining 50%. The costs listed below include the tree, delivery, installation and mulch. Participation in the program is strictly voluntary, is limited to owner-occupied homes and is on a first come first served basis.

Trees can be placed only within the parkway. Residents may suggest locations for their trees but locations will be reviewed for suitability and utility conflicts. The final location will be at the discretion of the Public Works Department.

The Village will plant the trees in late May / early June (as weather permits) and will monitor the health of the tree during the initial growing season.

Placement

Each new parkway tree must be placed midway between the curb (or pavement edge) and the sidewalk (or 7' from the pavement for locations without sidewalk) at least 25' from any other parkway trees, at least 10' from a driveway and at least 25' from an intersection. Please do not select locations next to manholes, fire hydrants or street lights.

Every attempt will be made to locate the tree as indicated on the order form. Please make your drawing as clear as possible, noting the location of your house, the curb, the sidewalk, driveways, intersections, existing trees, fire hydrants or any other objects in the area.

	Triumph Elm – 2.5" Dia. (60' tall x 40' spread at maturity) upright vase shaped fast growing tree with yellow fall foliage. Resistant to Dutch elm disease.	\$243.00
	Chastity Pear – 2.5" Dia. (35' tall x 25' spread at maturity) Broad Pyramidal tree with white blossoms in the Spring. Fall leaf color is vibrant orange to red.	\$245.00
	Skyline Honeylocust – 2.5" Dia. (45' tall x 40-50' spread at maturity) rounded canopy, fast growing tree with golden yellow fall foliage. Tolerates salt, wind, heat and drought.	\$235.00
	American Sentry Linden – 2.5" Dia. (40'-45' tall x 25'-30' spread at maturity) an upright, pyramidal shaped, moderate growing tree with yellow spring flowers, yellow/gold fall foliage. Very adaptable to various soils and urban conditions. Resistant to Japanese beetles.	\$237.00
