Recreational Vehicle Parking Reminder

As boats and RVs start to make their way home for storage, the Village of Sugar Grove would like to remind residents of the RV parking ordinance (Section 6-3-8).

Campers, boats, utility trailers and other recreational vehicles may only be parked in a side or rear yard in residential areas. To be parked in a side or rear yard, vehicles must be on an improved surface such as concrete, blacktop or paving stone. Vehicles, such as those

described, may be parked in the front yard driveway for a period not to exceed seventytwo (72) hours for the purpose of loading and unloading such vehicles within any given fourteen (14) day period.

Prescription Take Back Day

On Saturday, October 29, 2022, the Village of Sugar Grove Police Department will host a drug take back event as part of the National DEA-sponsored Drug Take Back Day. The event will be held at Village Hall, 10 S. Municipal Drive, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

If you are unable to make it to the Take Back event, the Village of Sugar Grove also offers a Prescription Drug Drop Box Program. The public may safely dispose of unused/expired prescription or overthe-counter medication at the drop box located in the Village Hall entryway, 10 S. Municipal



Drive. The box is accessible to the public from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

Yard waste collection continues through Tuesday, November 29. All yard waste must be placed in biodegradable paper bags or in a rigid container no larger than 32 gallons, clearly marked "Yard Waste."

Please do not blow leaves or grassing clippings into the streets as doing so creates dangerous situations and can cause flooding.
