Mailbox Installation & Maintenance Reminders

Winter is here and the Village of Sugar Grove wants to remind residents that proper installation and maintenance of mailboxes can help reduce the risk of your mailbox being damaged during a snowstorm. While Village snow plow drivers are careful to avoid damaging mailboxes, with limited space to pile snow and hundreds of miles of roadway to plow during each snowstorm, it is difficult for drivers to completely avoid pushing snow against mailboxes.

Early December is the perfect time to check your mailbox post to ensure that it is solid and sturdy in the ground prior to severe winter weather. Once the ground is frozen, it is almost impossible to make the needed repairs to sturdy your mailbox. Here are some tips to ensure your mailbox is ready for the snow this winter season.

- Check that your mailbox post is straight and that the box is not leaning over the curb.
- Replace damaged or rotting posts.
- Check the connection point between the box and the post to ensure that the box is securely fastened.

The U.S. Postal Service provides guidelines for installing and placing a new mailbox at home in addition to maintenance tips. To view, visit sugargrovel.gov.

Winter Parking Restrictions

Per Village Code Section 6-3-7 (Winter Parking), it is unlawful to park any vehicle on any public street within the Village at any time during or after a snowfall wherein two (2) or more inches of snow have fallen until such street has been plowed.

Christmas Tree Pickup

Lakeshore Recycling Systems (LRS) will collect Christmas trees on your normal pickup day January 3 thru January 31.

Trees must be free of decorations, including tinsel. Flocked trees will not be accepted. Trees cannot be in a plastic bag. Trees longer than 6 feet must be cut into smaller pieces.

White Goods Collected - Air Conditioner, Boiler, Chiller, Clothes Dryer, Dehumidifier, Dishwasher, Freezer, Furnace, Heat Pump, Humidifier, Microwave Oven, Oven, Range, Stove, Water Coller, Water Heater.

Bulk Items - one item such as mattress, chair, table etc. is allowed per week. LRS recommends advance notification at service@LRSrecycles.com, however, it is not required. Mattresses and box springs must be taped closed in a plastic mattress cover.
