Whereas, the customer suddenly attacked the Walgreens employees and threatened them with a knife demanding the employees hand over drugs; and

Whereas, at great risk to himself and without considering his own safety, Michael F. Wright leapt over the pharmacy counter and subdued the attacker, holding him until the police arrived; and

Whereas, the Board of Township Trustees wishes to thank Michael F. Wright for his brave actions and selfless dedication to others in protecting the lives and property of his fellow citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, Ohio wishes to extend our sincere thanks and appreciation to Michael F. Wright for his courageous action in protecting his fellow citizens from a dangerous attack at great personal risk to himself.

Section 2. June 19, 2010 is hereby declared to be Michael F. Wright Day in Sycamore Township.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be incorporated within the permanent records of Sycamore Township, and a copy shall be presented to Michael F. Wright.
