

RESOLUTION 2011-105

A RESOLUTION HONORING THE KENWOOD BAPTIST CHURCH ON THE OCCASION OF ITS CENTENNIAL ANNIVERSARY

WHEREAS, in 1911 thirty five people gathered to organize the Evanston Baptist Church in order to worship and establish a ministry in the Cincinnati area; and

WHEREAS, the congregation grew rapidly in the community, soon outgrowing the original and subsequent places of worship established by the founders of the church; and

WHEREAS, in May, 1959, the church broke ground for a new sanctuary on Kenwood Road in Sycamore Township and the renamed Kenwood Baptist Church held its first services on Mother's Day in 1961; and

WHEREAS, the Kenwood Baptist Church has continued to grow both in congregation size and the church facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Kenwood Baptist church currently ministers to approximately five hundred adults, youth, and children and serves the community with youth activities, worship, choir, and educational opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township wishes to congratulate the Kenwood Baptist Church on the occasion of its 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary;


NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Township Trustees, Sycamore Township, Ohio:
