**RESOLUTION NO. 2016 - 111**

**A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE GLENOVER LIGHTING DISTRICT AND  
DISPENSING WITH THE SECOND READING**

**WHEREAS**, a contract and assessment for lighting the streets of Glenover Drive, Appleknoll Drive, Raidersrun Drive, Paw Paw Lane known as the Glenover Lighting District, will expire on December 31, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 515.081 provides a Board of Township Trustees may award a new contract for lighting unless the owners of lots and lands containing more than fifty percent of the front feet abutting on the streets of the lighting district petition the board to discontinue the lighting district; and

**WHEREAS**, no such petition has been filed with regard to the Glenover Lighting District; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing on the renewal of the lighting district was held on July 7, 2016, notice having first been given;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** The Glenover Lighting District which shall include the following streets: Glenover Drive, Appleknoll Drive, Raidersrun Drive, and Paw Paw Lane is hereby renewed.

**SECTION 2.** The costs of such lighting district shall be assessed against each parcel of real estate by the following method: by the foot frontage of the property bounding and abutting on the streets and public ways so lighted, at the rate of \$.35 per front foot per year.

**SECTION 3.** The assessment for such lighting shall be paid in ten equal annual installments and shall be paid and collected in the same manner in which real estate taxes are paid and collected.

**SECTION 4.** The Trustees of Sycamore Township upon at least a majority vote do hereby dispense with any requirement that this resolution be read on two separate days, and hereby authorize the adoption of this resolution upon its first reading.

**SECTION 5.** This resolution shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.


**SECTION 6.**

Upon the unanimous vote of the Sycamore Township Trustees, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of Sycamore Township. The reason for the emergency is to provide safe streets in the area of the lighting district.




