RESOLUTION 2016 - 66

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING NO PARKING ON A PORTION OF BAYBERRY DRIVE IN SYCAMORE TOWNSHIP, AND DISPENSING WITH SECOND READING

WHEREAS, in order to provide for safe streets and roads in Sycamore Township, Ohio;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Township Trustees of Sycamore Township, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Due to indiscriminate parking and to insure the free movement of vehicles and emergency vehicles on Bayberry Drive, a dedicated road in Sycamore Township, there shall be no parking on the south side of Bayberry Drive from the intersection of Bayberry Drive and Kenwood Road extending east a distance of 100 feet.

SECTION 2. The Township Maintenance Department shall install the appropriate signage as required by law to enforce this Resolution.






