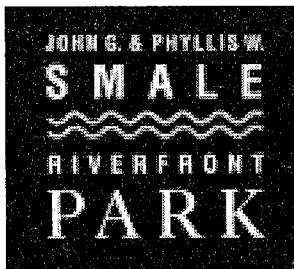
Founded in May 1864, Arlington National Cemetery before becoming our nation's resting place for our military and many famous Americans was a plantation and home of Robert E. Lee.
