

SPECIAL MEETING
TOWN OF WAYNESVILLE
BOARD OF ALDERMEN
TOWN HALL – 9 SOUTH MAIN STREET
JANUARY 30, 2012
MONDAY, 5:30 P.M.

The Board of Aldermen held a special meeting at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, January 30, 2012 at the Town Hall. Board Members present were Mayor Gavin Brown, Aldermen Gary Caldwell, Wells Greeley, Libba Feichter and LeRoy Roberson. Also present were Town Alderman-elect Julia Boyd Freeman, Town Manager Lee Galloway, Assistant Town Manager Alison Melnikova, Town Attorney Woodrow Griffin and Human Resources Director Margaret Langston.

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order at 5:40 p.m. and noted that the purpose of the meeting was to meet with Dr. Heather Lee of the consulting firm of Developmental Associates to discuss the applicants for the position of Town Manager for Waynesville. Applications were accepted over a six week period by Developmental Associates, and Dr. Lee has narrowed that list down to the individuals deemed to be most qualified for the position. This meeting was arranged so that Dr. Lee could present that list and work with the Town Board to trim the list down to a smaller number to invite to Waynesville to undergo the assessment center for the candidates.

Alderman Caldwell made a motion that the Board go into closed session in accordance with North Carolina General Statute 143-318.11(a)(6) to discuss personnel, specifically the applicants for the position of Town Manager of Waynesville. This motion was seconded by Alderman Greeley and passed unanimously. The Board went into closed session at 6:50 p.m.

After a period of discussion, Alderman Feichter moved that the Board reconvene into open session. This motion was seconded by Alderman Greeley and passed unanimously. The Board returned to open session at 7:44 p.m.

With no further business, Alderman Caldwell moved that the Board adjourn. This motion was seconded by Alderman Feichter and passed unanimously at 7:45 p. m.
