PUBLIC ART COMMISSION

At present, the Commission is involved in the selection of works of art to be located at the new Town facility being constructed for the Police and Development Operations at the corner of South Main and East Streets.

There have been two applications received for the spots available on the Public Art Commission, one from Starr Hogan and one from Mieko Thomson, and these applications are attached for the review of the Town Board. The Board could appoint these two individuals or could opt to solicit more applications from the public. We have only become aware of these vacancies within the past few weeks and there may be those in the public who are interested in the vacancies.

- ITEM 3. ANNEXATION PETITION - .249 ACRES AT 2018 DELLWOOD ROAD  
KEVIN AND MELANIE SANDEFUR

The Town has received a petition from Kevin and Melanie Sandefur for the annexation of a .249 acre parcel of land at 2018 Dellwood Road which they own. Attached you will see maps which show the area covered by this request, and the .249 acres lies just west and next to the Sunoco Oil gas station.

If the Board wishes to consider this satellite annexation, the next step would be to adopt a resolution directing Town Clerk Phyllis McClure to investigate the sufficiency of this petition. She would likely have a report back for the Board at your regularly scheduled meeting on December 9, 2009.
