

The Waynesville ABC Board held their regular scheduled meeting November 20, 2012 at the office. Present at the meeting were Earl Clark, Jack Swanger, Ray Ezell, Joy Rasmus, Waynesville Police Officers, Aldridge, Shuler, and, Howell. Chairman Clark called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Jack motioned that the minutes of the October 17, 2012 meeting approved as read; motioned carried.

The Waynesville Police Officers met with the board to say they have recently had additional training in the ABC laws mainly involving the mixed beverage accounts, and wanted the board to know they were there to help with anything the board may need from them. They also inquired as to the Law Enforcement contribution continuing, and to the percentage of the contribution.

The manager gave the following sales report.

There was an increase in sales of \$4,916.67; 2.33% compared to October 2011.

The October financial statements were reviewed by the Board.

The NABCA distributed letters to all ABC Boards, and software providers. They will begin collecting weekly sales data from on premise accounts. The Board approved the \$250.00 programming cost to Carolina Data Systems for the new requirement from NABCA.
