The Waynesville Historic Preservation Commission held a regular meeting on Wednesday, February 5, 2003. Members present were Ron Fleenor, Warren Gresham, Shawn Leatherwood and Bob Breese. Others present were Planner Andrew Powell and Town Clerk Phyllis McClure. Acting Chairman Ron Fleenor called the meeting to order at 2:25 p.m.

Approval of Minutes of January 8, 2003

Bob Breese moved, seconded by Shawn Leatherwood, to approve the minutes of the January 8, 2003 meeting as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

Request for Local Historic Landmark Designation Nomination "Alden House" 135 Pigeon Street - Susan and Robert Beasley

Susan and Robert Beasley have added more information to their application for historic designation of the property located at 135 Pigeon Street. Ms. Beasley attended the meeting to answer questions if necessary.

Bob Breese moved, seconded by Shawn Leatherwood, to recommend sending Susan and Robert Beasley's application to the Division of Archives and History in Asheville for local historic landmark designation nomination for the "Alden House" located at 135 Pigeon Street.

Request for Candidates for Appointment to the Historic Preservation Commission

Ron Fleenor asked the commission members to consider possible names to present to the Board of Aldermen for appointment to the Historic Preservation Commission. He asked that the members call Andrew or Phyllis with those recommendations. Ron Fleenor agreed to serve as Acting Chairman until elections at the April 2003 meeting.

The commission terms for Helen Malina, Shawn Leatherwood and Georgia Forney expired January 31, 2003. Ms. Malina and Ms. Forney both declined reappointment on the Historic Preservation Commission. Shawn was reappointed to serve a four (4) year term. Helen has served as Chairman since the Commission was established (for the past eight (8) years). Ms. Malina asked that Phyllis McClure pass along her farewell to the other commission members and to encourage them to take advantage of all training opportunities related to their service on the commission.

It was the consensus of the commission that Phyllis McClure draft a letter of appreciation from the commission to Helen Malina for their signatures at the next regular meeting.
