The Historic Preservation Commission held a regular meeting on Wednesday, October 7, 2009 to tour the Spread Out historic district. Members present were Chairman Nikki Owens, David Felmet Jr., Sandra Owen, Bette Sprecher, and Peter Sterling. Town Planner Paul Benson and consultant Clay Griffith were also present.
