Chairman George Kenney called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. New Commission Member Mel Bennett was sworn in before the meeting.

1. Minutes from the March 14th regular meeting

Ms. Ann Melton made a motion, seconded by Ms. Leigh Forrester to accept the March 14th, 2019 regular meeting minutes as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

2. Treasurer’s Report – Sarah Jane League

Ms. League was absent. No treasurers report to present.

3. Discussion concerning new coloring books.

Ms. Forrester informed that she was currently editing the coloring books.

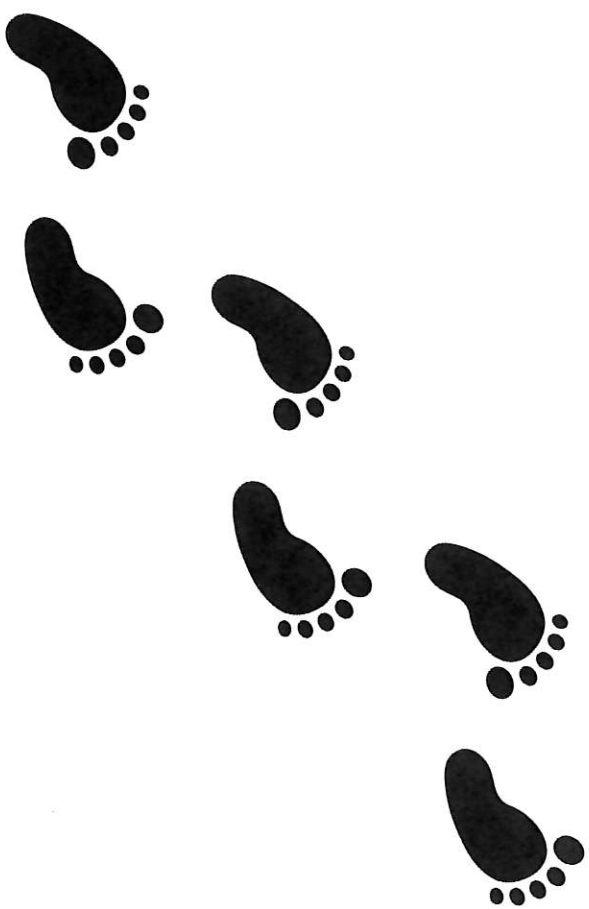
