Chairman George Kenney called the meeting to order at 4:04 p.m.

Introduction of new Commission Members

Chairman Kenney welcomed two new members, Skip Middleton, and James Cuellar, to the Commission, and asked them to introduce themselves.

1. Minutes from the July 8, 2021 regular meeting

Ms. Vicki Mangieri made a motion, seconded by Mr. Steve Lloyd to accept the July 8, 2021 regular meeting minutes. The motion carried unanimously.

2. Treasurer’s Report

Mr. Steve Lloyd presented the Financial Report as follows:

Currently, the fund balance for the Waynesville Public Art Commission is \$23,550.96. The Art Commission’s previous balance owed toward the Plott Hound Sculpture was \$1,498.65. This fiscal

year we have taken in \$4,553 in donations. Of that, \$250 was from a private donation and \$303 was earned at the Folkmoot Festival. These two donations bring the balance owed toward the Plott Hound Sculpture down to \$945.65.

We broke \$1,000 and are very close to reaching our goal to begin fundraising towards a new piece!

Assistant Manager Jesse Fowler told the Commission he had received two more donations to the Commission totaling \$500.00 which would bring the total owed on the Plott Hound Sculpture down to \$445.65.

3. Discussion of new art installation

There was discussion of the proposed project of placing an art piece at the Pigeon Community Center. Chairman Kenney gave some of the history of the Pigeon Community and how the art piece would honor that community and brought the new members up to date on the area and the project.

4. Dog Show Logistic-September 19, 2021 – Dog Prizes?

Assistant Manager Fowler showed the Commission the awards that would be presented to each category for the Dog show. Chairman Kenney confirmed that the square from the Hart Theater could be used again for taking debit and credit cards for the entry fees. The score sheets, Master of Ceremonies (Modine) and judges, hot dog vender, and tent, were also confirmed. Ms. Vicki Mangieri said she will donate DVDs of herself as Modine to each winner. The Commission also discussed advertising, and sponsors for the show.

5. Merchandise and Fundraising

➤ Table at Church Street and Apple Festival

The Commission will be selling t-shirts and books at tables at the upcoming Church Street on October 9th, and Apple Festival on October 16th. Mr. James Cuellar volunteered to man the table for the Church Street Festival from 10:00 am – 1:30 pm. Ms. Mangieri will be at the table 1:30 pm - 5:00 pm.

➤ Hotel requests?

Assistant Manager Fowler explained to the Commission that the Public Art Books can be distributed to hotels with a minimum of 20 for \$3.00 each and be available to patrons for sale or give away.

6. Other Business

Chairman Keeney reminded everyone that there is one more meeting before the Dog Show on September 19th.

7. Adjourn

With no further business, a motion was made by Skip Middleton, seconded by James Cuellar, to adjourn the meeting at 4:58 pm. The motion carried unanimously.
