Chairman George Kenney called the meeting to order at 4:06 p.m. He introduced Vicki Mangieri as a new Art Commission member. Ms. Mangieri told the Commission members a little about herself.

1. Minutes from the October 5th, 2020 regular Meeting.

*A motion was made by Commission Member Leigh Forrester, seconded by Commission Member Vicki Mangieri, to approve the October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020 regular meeting minutes as presented. The motion passed unanimously.*

## 2. Treasurer's Report

Assistant Town Manager, Jesse Fowler gave the Treasurer's Report: Total Revenue \$23,125.00. Mr. Fowler stated that he had to speak with Sarah Jane to determine how much was still owed on the Plott Hound. He stated that he also met with the finance department. The total amount in the fund balance in July was \$18,337. There have been \$4,788 in donations this year. He explained that this means that at the end of the year the fund balance will increase to at least \$23,125.00.

Commission Member Jessi Stone said they could have a virtual dog show and Smokey Mountain news might be able to sponsor it. The board thought that was a great idea and talked about categories that could be judged. Ms. Stone stated the prize winner's picture can be placed in the newspaper.

## 3. Fundraising/Hotel, Motel, and BNB teams.

Chairman George Kenney, and Assistant Town Manager, Jesse Fowler talked about selling the art books for \$5.00 each and in bulk of 20 or more at \$3.00 each. The Art Commission talked about going to different motels, hotels, and bed and breakfasts in groups of 2 or more.

Mr. Kenney said he was going to go to the Terrace Hotel, Lambuth and BNB Slice of Heaven.

Ms. Leigh Forrester said she would go to the Yellow House, Oak Hill on Love Ln. and Andon Reid Inn,

Ms. Mangieri said she will go to Econno lodge.

Mr. Llyod said he would go to Best Western, Smokey Mountain Inn, and Comfort Inn.

Ms. Stone said she would go to Twin Brooks, Meadowlark, Brook Side Mountain Mist, and the Swag.

Mr. DePaolo said he would go to Castlewood Inn, Comfort Inn-Maggie, Red Leaf River

Chairman Kenney said they would pick back up to finish the list in January. He asked the Commission to come back with some ideas for the next art project.

Mr. Fowler said there was going to be a meeting at the Obama-King Park on Friday 20th at 4:00pm. Three of the Commission Members, Mr. Kenney, Libba Feichter, and Leigh Forrester were going to attend.

*A motion was made by Commission Member Steve Lloyd, seconded by Commission Member Jessi Stone to adjourn the meeting at 4:45. The motion passed unanimously.*
