

**WAYNESVILLE PARKS AND RECREATION  
ADVISORY COMMISSION  
MINUTES  
OCTOBER 11, 2005**

Kenny Mull called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m.

The minutes for September were read. Don made the motion to approve and Kitty second. Approved by all.

**Old Business:**

The annual bridge tournament was held September 16,17,18.

**New Business:**

**Men's basketball** has 12 teams. They play on Monday and Thursday nights. Games begin October 17. **The gym has been rented by the county recreation dept.** again this year for their youth basketball league. Games are on Saturdays during January and February. They also rent the gym on Tuesday nights for practice. **Western Carolina University**, women basketball team, held a **"Meet the Lady Cats"** day here on October 8. A hoop shoot contest was held and prizes were given out.

**Learn to swim classes** are full and going well for October. We now have two classes of **water aerobics**.

**The judo tournament** was held October 1 at the Old Armory Center. There were 58 competitors. A new **quilting and pottery class** begins November 19. Items made will be available for purchase. Also a **special needs pottery class** will be offered and co-sponsored by ARC of Haywood.

**The monthly dance** for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> grades was held on the 7<sup>th</sup>. There were 157 who attended. \$785.00 was collected.

**The Halloween Creepy Creek Crawl hay ride and Spooky Lagoon** will be held on October 28, from 7pm-9pm. Admission is \$2.00.

All advertised **recreation programs** in the newsletter have had enough participants to be classified as a success.

**Membership promotions** for October are underway and drawings will be held in November. T-shirts and passes will be given away.

We are planning some type of special recognition for our **5<sup>th</sup> year of center operation**.

December 18 will mark our 5<sup>th</sup> year.

**The monthly review and newsletter** was distributed.

**Other Business:**

Kitty asked about the prospects of building the **outdoor pool**. At this point phase III is in the long range capital budget. The year for accomplishing this has not been determined.

Kitty said that someone had asked her about a **program study being done at the Armory**. We

are not conducting such a study, however the county recreation department is conducting a study and we are helping with the distribution of the surveys. This is in conjunction with the Council of Government appointed county wide recreation committee which is attempting to set up a county wide master plan.
