- We have recently hired Rebecca Boswell and Michael Huffstetter. Rebecca will oversee the summer camp, child care and programs at the Waynesville Recreation Center and Michael will oversee the programs at the Old Army Recreation Center.
- The gym and aerobics room floors were refinished. It was reported by many members that the smell was not quite as bad as last year.
- We now have several more volunteers at the Waynesville Recreation Center. These volunteers are helping in the cardio area upstairs and in the concession stand.
