



ADVISORY COMMISSION MEETING

April 8, 2008
6:30 PM

MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 6:38 pm.

In attendance were: Sarah Massie, Rhonda Schandavel, Don Frady, Michelle Schumacher, Scotty Schulhofer, Kenny Mull, Wallace Messer, Mike Goodwin, Michael Huffstetler and Rhett Langston. Lee Starnes was unable to attend.

Kenny read the minutes from the March 11 meeting. Wallace made the motion to approve and Scotty second. Approved by all.

Old Business:

- None

New Business:

- Michael Huffstetler gave a short presentation on the Old Armory and outdoor programming. This included four new horse shoe pits, a pickleball tournament on May 8, a day hike program, a whitewater rafting trip, a backpacking trip, and a frisbee disc golf tournament for Region 9 on June 28.
- The idea was presented to charge a rental fee for shelter reservations. Session #1 (11 am—1 pm) and session #2 (4—6 pm) would cost \$35 each. Don Frady suggested to charge \$45 in case someone wanted to rent the shelter from 11 am to 6 pm. Everyone agreed. This would be offered as session #3.
- Wallace made a motion to recommend building a skatepark utilizing the \$70K as seed money and with the rest of the money coming from fundraising and grants. Rhonda second it. Everyone voted and the recommendation passed.
- We will have a new display arranged in the Waynesville Recreation Center pertaining to the history of Sulphur Springs Park. The park will also serve as part of the historical tour on July 5.
- Rhett will give a presentation to the Board of Aldermen on Friday.
- The idea was presented to construct a large shelter at the site of the old pool in Recreation Park. The benefits would include programming and having a place for large groups to have lunch, etc. Also, it could be a potential new home for the farmers market.
- The Vision Team will meet on April 22. This will be the first meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:40 pm.
