MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 5:35 pm.

- None

New Business:

- We will make a presentation to the Waynesville Kiwanis Club on Thursday, May 14, for a \$20,000 grant for the Waynesville Skate Park.
- The PARTF funding has been delayed from May 22 to July. The reason is due to travel restrictions.
- On May 6, a tornado warning was issued to Haywood County until 10:45 am. We enacted our tornado drill that is in the Emergency Operations Plan. The staff knew exactly what to do in protecting the citizens in both the Waynesville Recreation Center and the Old Armory Recreation Center.
- We will offer a youth flag football season this June and July. The organizational meeting went well with about 17 kids present.
- Senior tennis has now started at Recreation Park.
- We will offer a new teen swimming program and a strength / endurance training for teens.
- Both pools are now VGB compliant. We also closed our pool for a week recently for this, to clean and to do patch work.
- On Saturday, May 9, the first annual "Autism Fun Ride in the Smokies" was held. A total of 31 bikers participated in the event and close to \$600 was raised. All proceeds will go to help pay for children participate in the ASPY program.
- We turned a study in the town administration regarding resident vs non-resident fees. The study included examples from other municipalities.
