MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm.

In attendance were: Sarah Massie, Eva Hansen, Wallace Messer, Megan Houser, and Kim Gardner. Bill Skelton, Laura Turner, Wayne Finger, Dan Schultz, and Nicole Kott were unable to attend.

New Business:

- Eva Hansen presented the Tot Lot Renovation and new natural play area at the Kiwanis Playground in Recreation Park to the Advisory Commission for approval for the design. Those present did approve. Also, Bill Skelton, Dan Schultz, Nicole Kott approved via email (attached). The majority of the funding will come from the Waynesville Kiwanis. The Waynesville Parks and Recreation Department will contribute a small portion. The designs will now be presented to the Town of Waynesville Board of Aldermen meeting on May 11 for final approval before moving forward with the project.
- The Town of Waynesville Development Department and the Parks and Recreation Department will submit the PARTF application for the bridge, outdoor exercise equipment, athletic field and 1/4 greenway by May 1. We had over 400 responses for the greenway survey.
- We will have a 5K on Saturday, April 24, at 9 am with KARE and Hope for Horses.
- We still have not made a decision for summer camp. The governor's office is still waiting on summer camp guidelines from the CDC.
- The Town of Waynesville is considering leasing or buying a house / work barn across the street from the Waynesville Skate Park. If this happens then the outdoor maintenance department will move into it.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 5:58 pm.
