MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 5:45 pm.

New Business:

- We have hired a new aquatics staff. Amy Boswell will be the new supervisor, Brandon Cox will be the head life guard and Paige Parker will be the full time life guard.
- The new rate increased was approved by the Board of Aldermen and will go into effect beginning August 3.
- Our numbers for our soccer camp are down compared to the previous year. We had a good basketball camp and we are also make more improvements to the softball fields. We are purchasing a net for safety reasons to go on top of the outfield fence at the Recreation Park field and we are also going to crown the Vance Street field.
- Mike Goodwin, Malcom Beasley, Geoff Fowler and Brandon Cox each obtained their Certified Pool Operator certification. Amy Boswell also has her CPO.
- Jonathon Yates (Town of Waynesville Horticulturalist) and Tim Plowman conducted the Environmental Camp for the first time. We had 14 children participate. This was a week long camp.
- Our summer camp numbers are doing well. We are a little lower than last year but we are averaging 30 to 35 campers per week.
- The first Adventure Camp had to be cancelled due to lack of participation. We are planning on conducting week #2 and week #3.
- We went over the June Monthly Report emphasizing the total revenue for the fiscal year at \$717,000. This passed our goal at \$700,000.
- We will have a volunteer work day for the Skate Park on July 25 and our next fundraising meeting will be July 28 at 5:30 pm.
