The meeting was called to order at 5:40 pm.

- None

New Business:

- Donald Hummel will offer the Crossfire Basketball Camp and British Soccer Camp. Registration for each camp is going well.
- Swim lessons will begin in June.
- Tim Plowman has senior trips scheduled to see the Asheville Tourists, Cades Cove, Grove Park Inn Smoky Mountain Center for the Performing Arts and a Lake Lure boat tour.
- Summer camp registration has been slow to date. We have offered different promotions including a sibling discount in order to increase enrollment.
- Michael Huffstetler and myself took a trip to Pickens, South Carolina, in order to visit a company called Zest Quest. We are hoping to have Michael visit a variety of elementary schools, Waynesville Middle School and Tuscola High School to promote fitness and nutrition.
