MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 5:40 pm.

Old Business:

- None

New Business:

- We will offer a volleyball camp, British Soccer Camp, Brazilian Soccer Camp, Crossfire Basketball Camp and On Court Academy Basketball Camp.
- Both pools will be resurfaced early in the fiscal year (August or September).
- The Senior Program Guides are now out. This covers June 1—August 31.
- Our summer camps will begin next week. The counselors have been hired and includes three future teachers. We are very excited about the camp and the staff for this summer.
- The Advisory Commission recommended to incorporate a student rate for high school and college students. This would be the same rate as seniors. It was also recommended to raise the senior age for rates from 55 to 60. This would have to be approved by the Board of Aldermen.
- We have received the Senior Friendly certification from Haywood Community Connections and Western Carolina University. This involved an inspection of the Waynesville Recreation Center from a panel of seniors and students from WCU and we had to meet a list of criteria of services for senior citizens. Then at least 25% of the Waynesville Parks and Recreation Department staff had to go through a training session provided by WCU. Our next goal is to have the Old Armory certified as well.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:14 pm.
