MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 6:25 pm.

Old Business:

- None

New Business:

- The monthly report from September was reviewed.
- Base Camp Waynesville will be a new program that teaches people of all ages about hiking, fishing, kayaking, rafting and other outdoor adventures. This will be open to all ages. We will use the game room as the base location to have introductory classes and to teach beginning tactics to each individual program.
- It was agreed to start having our advisory meetings on the third Tuesday of the month. We will start in November.
- There are a lot of requests from skaters to have lights at the skate park so skaters can use it until 10 pm. At this point in time there are a lot of other needs that will need to be addressed. This may be something that can be incorporated into the master plan process. In the mean time the town would purchase new lights if the skating community would like to raise the money for it.
- The advisory commission all agreed that it was a good idea to post the "no concealed weapons" at the Waynesville Recreation Center and Old Armory and not to have it mentioned on the rules signs in the parks.
- We will soon issue the RFP for the master plan to interested companies.
- The old restrooms have been removed and new mobile restrooms should arrive around October 21 or 22.
- Rhett will mail the Waynesville Parks and Recreation Department Risk Management Plan to all members of the advisory commission for review and to approve at the November meeting.
- It was agreed that more research should go into renting out the skate park until decisions are made as to the cost and liability.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:05 pm.
