The meeting was called to order at 5:40 pm.

New Business:

- The monthly report for August was reviewed.
- The sauna will be located on the pool deck. This was based upon two things: we would have to construct outer walls if we installed in the locker rooms and harder to manage in the locker rooms. I spoke with the representative from the company we are purchasing the sauna from and he said that the pool deck was the most popular choice.
- We will be moving the community garden from the Old Armory to East Street Park due to restructuring the parking lot.
- We have new cameras installed. Our new total will be 19 and the grand total will be 28.
- We had a successful week of closing in terms of what we wanted to accomplish. This is included the new camera installation, cleaning the pool deck, installing a new boiler, painting, and refinishing the gym floor, racquetball court and aerobics room.
- We are sad to report that Marla Wengyn, our massage therapist, will be leaving after 7 1/2 years.
- We have 13 new picnic tables in our parks. This was given to us by the old prison.
- The Mud Run that took place on September 13 was very successful. This was done by the Canton Lions Club. There were over 280 participants. Ryan Jacobson, the organizer of the event, did an outstanding job.
- It was decided to charge a minimum of \$50 or \$2 per person for any type of reservations in our parks that did not include normal rental items (such as a picnic shelter, ball field, etc.). If the rental item has to be used then that fee would be tacked on as well to the final invoice.
