

**ORDINANCE 2017-O-6**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF WINTHROP HARBOR**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of at least a simple majority of the corporate authorities of the Village of Winthrop Harbor, it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interest of the Village of Winthrop Harbor to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Winthrop Harbor to donate personal property to another Illinois Fire Department for their use;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WINTHROP HARBOR, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS THAT:**

**SECTION ONE.** Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Winthrop Harbor finds that the following personal property, to wit fire hoses, now owned by the Village of Winthrop Harbor, is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Winthrop Harbor and the best interests of the Village are served by donating the aforementioned property to an Illinois Fire Department in need of such equipment.

**SECTION TWO.** Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Fire Chief is hereby authorized and directed to donate the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village of Winthrop Harbor.

**SECTION THREE. REPEALER CLAUSE**

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION FOUR. SEVERABILITY.**

The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any section, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held to be illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Trustees that this ordinance would have been enacted as if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part, provision, or other subdivision had not been included herein.

**SECTION FIVE. WHEN EFFECTIVE.** This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication, as provided by law.
