

ORDINANCE 2019-O-1

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR DISPOSAL
OF PERSONAL PROPERTY ACQUIRED THROUGH THE
DLA / LESO PROGRAMS**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of not less than simple majority of the corporate authorities of the Village of Winthrop Harbor, it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interest of the Village of Winthrop Harbor to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Winthrop Harbor acquired the property described on Exhibit A hereto through the federal programs known as DLA and LESO, which are generally described as programs which distribute used and surplus military hardware to local law enforcement agencies, which programs are jointly administered by the Department of Defense and the Illinois State Police, and

WHEREAS, disposal of surplus property is governed by LESO rules and regulations both federal and State of Illinois, and their respective program managers, and the Village intends to comply in all respects with these rules and regulations, and

WHEREAS, the property described on Exhibit A hereto has been approved for disposal, by both Federal and State program managers, and the orders of disposal allow certain equipment including some military hardware to be sold or transferred to both private and public entities, and

WHEREAS, a separate Village account labeled DLA was established to track income and expenses related to the Village LESO account, consistent with the governing federal and state rules and regulations, and

WHEREAS, no Village tax dollars have been used to purchase or dispose of any LESO equipment including all aircraft and parts assigned to the Air One Program, which has ceased operations.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Winthrop Harbor that the property described on Exhibit A hereto should be sold or disposed of on such terms as the Mayor and the Chief of Police should agree upon;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WINTHROP HARBOR, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS THAT:

SECTION ONE. Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Winthrop Harbor finds that the personal property described on Exhibit A hereto now owned by the Village of Winthrop Harbor, is no longer necessary or useful to the


Village of Winthrop Harbor and the best interests of the Village are served by selling or disposing the aforementioned property in a fashion most suitable to return the highest net cash benefit to the Village.

SECTION TWO. Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Mayor and Chief of Police are hereby authorized and directed to sell or dispose of the property listed on Exhibit A for the best cash price possible, considering the age and condition of the said property, and for the Clerk to execute such sales documents, titles and the like as necessary to complete the transaction or transactions.

SECTION THREE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication, as provided by law.
