

ORDINANCE 2020 – O - 22

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF WINTHROP HARBOR**

WHEREAS, the Village recently experienced a very expensive water main valve break near the intersection of 9th Street and Russell Avenue, and

WHEREAS, at the time the current budget and appropriation ordinance were passed, it was not anticipated that this expense was likely, and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that it is necessary and appropriate to increase the amount on one line item on the appropriation ordinance and its related budget in order to show the expenses incurred in fixing this catastrophic line break and to transfer funds from water reserves to cover the same,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Winthrop Harbor, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The annual appropriation ordinance and its related budget are hereby amended as follows:

Water Expense line 60-60-4540 is increased by \$48,915.08

Water Reserves are decreased by \$48,915.08

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
