Traffic Arrest(s):

On 04/09/2015, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 1800 block of Russell Road for Speeding. The driver, **Eshaunte C. Williams**, 18, of Zion was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed he had a suspended Illinois Driver's License. Williams was issued citations for Speeding, Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle, and Driving While License Suspended. Williams was later released on scene by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

On 04/10/2015, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 100 block of Sheridan Road for Speeding. The driver, **Aasyeya E. Baldwin**, 26, of Kenosha, Wisconsin was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed she had a suspended Wisconsin Driver's License. Baldwin was issued citations for Speeding, Child Not Secured In Child Restraint Seat (two counts), and Driving While License Suspended.
