Traffic Arrest(s):

On 11/25/2015, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 600 block of Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Tedarl Farrier**, 61, of Kenosha, Wisconsin was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests. Farrier was issued citations for Speeding, Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol with a BAC over 0.08. Farrier was later released by a notice to appear pending a future court date.

On 11/29/2015, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 1500 block of Sheridan Road learning the registered owner was currently suspended. The driver, **Jade N. Hall**, 21, of Kenosha, Wisconsin was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed his driver's license had been suspended. Hall was issued a citation for Driving While License Suspended. Hall was later released by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

On 12/05/2015, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 100 block of Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Valerie L. On 11/30/2015, an Officer conducting routine patrol was flag down by a pedestrian related to a report of a domestic battery and it was additionally reported the suspect was in possession of a shotgun. After further investigation and a search of the residence was conducted by the Officers; resulted in the subsequent arrest of **Justin K. McMackin**, 33, of Winthrop Harbor. After reviewing the facts of this case with the Lake County States Attorney's Office; McMackin was issued citations for Domestic battery/bodily harm, Unlawful Use of a Weapon by Felon, and 2 counts of Aggravated Assault. McMackin was later transported to the Lake County Jail pending a bond hearing.
