Traffic Arrests:

On 01/21/2016, an Officer stopped a vehicle near the intersection of 6th Street and Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Alexandra D. Lopez**, 22, of Waukegan was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed her driver's license had been suspended. Lopez was issued citations for Speeding and Driving While License Suspended. Lopez was later released by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

On 01/23/2016, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 700 block of Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Lorenzo L. Bradley**, 22 of West Lafayette, Indiana was subsequently taken into custody after Officers located cannabis and a loaded handgun inside of the motor vehicle. Bradley was later charged with Speeding, Driving Under the Influence of Drugs, Unlawful Possession of Cannabis with the Intent to Deliver, Unlawful Possession of Cannabis, and Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon. The front seat passengers **Demetrus L. Woods-McKissick**, 22, of Waukegan and **Michael D. Hill**, 24, of Waukegan were both subsequently taken into custody for having an outstanding in-state warrant and were charged with Unlawful Possession of Cannabis with the Intent to Deliver, Unlawful Possession of Cannabis, Aggravated Unlawful Possession of a Firearm, and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm by Felon. Bradley, Woods-McKissick, and Hill were later transported to the Lake County Jail pending a bond hearing.

On 01/25/2016, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 500 block of Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Phillip R. Tate**, 35, of Fort Wayne, Indiana was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests. Tate was issued citations for Speeding, Improper Lane Usage, Driving While License Suspended, and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Tate was later released by a notice to appear pending a future court date.
