Traffic Arrest(s):

On 03/25/2016, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 1100 block of Lewis Avenue for speeding. The driver, **Orilla Williams**, 51, of Zion was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed she had a suspended Illinois Driver's License. Williams was issued citations for Speeding, Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle, and Driving While License Suspended. Williams was released on scene by a notice to appear pending a future court date.

Warrant Arrest:

On 03/23/2016, an Officer was dispatched within the 1100 block of Monroe related to an unrelated follow up investigation. Later the Officer learned a subject, **Scott O.
