### **Traffic Arrest(s):**

On 07/17/2017, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 2700 block of 9<sup>th</sup> Street for speeding. The driver, **Lucas Espinosa-Castellanos**, 46, of Waukegan, was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed his Illinois Driver's License was suspended. Espinosa-Castellanos was issued citations for Speeding and Driving While License Suspended. Espinosa-Castellanos was released on scene by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.
