Traffic Arrest(s):

On 08/07/2017, an Officer stopped an unregistered motorized bicycle near the intersection of Willson Avenue and 3rd Street. The driver, **Mycel A. Schwartz**, 18, of Winthrop Harbor was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed his Illinois Driver's License had been suspended. Mycel A. Schwartz was issued citations for No Valid Motor Vehicle Registration, Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle, and Driving While License Suspended. Mycel A. Schwartz was later released by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

On 08/11/2017, an Officer was dispatched to a property damage traffic accident involving two motor vehicles near the intersection 7th Street and North Point Drive. The driver, **Anna M. Williams**, 31, of Chicago was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests. Anna M. Williams was issued citations for Failure to Reduce Speed to Avoid an Accident and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Anna M. Williams was later released by a notice to appear pending a future court date.
