Traffic Arrest(s):

On 09/26/2017, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 800 block of Sheridan Road for Speeding. The driver, **Gabriel Martinez**, 27, of Zion was issued citations for Speeding and Driving While License Suspended. Martinez was later released on scene by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

On 09/26/2017, an Officer stopped a vehicle near the intersection of 9th Street and West Broadway for Speeding. The driver, **Alexander R. Hilario-Reyes**, 19, of Milwaukee was issued citations for Speeding and Driving While License Suspended. Hilario-Reyes was later released on scene by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

On 09/30/2017, an Officer was dispatched near the intersection of 9th Street and Washington Avenue related to a possible intoxicated driver. The Officer located and stopped the suspected motor vehicle for a lane and equipment violation within the 700 block of Sheridan Road. The driver, **James D. Walldan**, 32, of Winthrop Harbor was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety testing. Walldan was issued citations for Failure to Signal when required and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Walldan was later released by a notice to appear pending a future court date.

On 09/24/2017, Officers were dispatched within the 1700 block of 9th Street related to a report of a domestic battery. After further investigation conducted by the Officer's resulted in the subsequent arrest of **Cory F. Hergenreder**, 21, of Gurnee. After later reviewing the facts of this case with the Lake County States Attorney's Office, Hergenreder was charged with Domestic Battery and Resisting a Peace Officer. Hergenreder was later transported to the Lake County Jail pending a bond hearing.

On 09/25/2017, Officers were dispatched within the 700 block of Franklin Avenue related to a report of a domestic battery. After further investigation conducted by the Officer's resulted in the subsequent arrest of **Thomas T. Chapman**, 47, of Winthrop Harbor. After later reviewing the facts of this case with the Lake County States Attorney's Office, Chapman was charged with Aggravated Domestic Battery. Chapman was later transported to the Lake County Jail pending a bond hearing.
