Traffic Arrest(s):

On 10/25/2017, an Officer stopped a motor vehicle within the 600 block of Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Nikea N. Glaspie**, 35, Zion, was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests. Glaspie was issued citations for Speeding, Failure to Secure Child in Child Restraint Seat, Driving While License Revoked (Felony Enhanced), Endangering the Life of a Child (4 counts), Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol with a BAC over 0.08. Glaspie was later transported to the Lake County Jail pending a bond hearing.

On 10/27/2017, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 600 block of Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Cedric D. Gaston**, 21, of Racine, Wisconsin was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed he had a suspended driver's license.
