### **Traffic Arrest(s):**

11/05/2017, an Officer stopped a motor vehicle within the 800 block of Sheridan Road for a lane violation. The driver, **Saul Ortegon-Avitia**, 32, of Park City, was subsequently taken into custody for suspicion of Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Ortegon-Avitia was issued citations for Failure to Yield to Emergency Vehicle, Child Endangerment (2 counts), and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Ortegon-Avitia was later released by a notice to appear pending a future court date.

11/06/2017, an Officer stopped a motor vehicle within the 1200 block of Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Rachel A. Boyd**, 36, of Waukegan, was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed she had a suspended driver's license. Boyd was issued citations for Speeding and Driving While License Suspended. Boyd was later released by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

Upon Officer's arrival, the suspect fled from the area. After a further investigation had been conducted, assistance from the area media's, and social media; the suspect, **Sean P. Schuman**, 38, of Bassett, Wisconsin was identified, interviewed, and subsequently taken into custody at the Twin Lakes Police Department. Schuman was issued a non-traffic citation for Retail Theft. Schuman was later released by a notice to appear pending a future court date.
