Traffic Arrest(s):

On 11/14/2017, an Officer stopped a motor vehicle within the 500 block of Sheridan Road for a lane violation. The driver, **Tammy T. Lott**, 42, of Kenosha, Wisconsin was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed she had a suspended driver's license. Lott was issued citations for Improper Lane Usage and Driving While License Suspended. Lott was later released by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

On 11/17/2017, an Officer stopped a vehicle near the intersection of North Park Avenue and Sheridan Road for a seat belt violation. The driver, **Kristin C. Fuqua**, 28, of Winthrop Harbor was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed she had a revoked driver's license. Fuqua was issued citations for Failure to Wear Seat Belt and Driving While License Revoked. Fuqua was later released by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

Identity Theft:

On 11/13/2017, an Officer was dispatched to the lobby at the Winthrop Harbor Police Department related to an identity theft complaint. The complainant advised some unknown person(s) opened a debit card in their name and charged over \$7,000 USD. This incident is pending further investigation.

Failure to Report Change of Address:

On 11/17/2017, while Officers were conducting a follow up investigation related to a compliance check of a sex offender within the 900 block of South Park Avenue. The subject,

Shawn M. Morris, 31, of Winthrop Harbor was subsequently taken into custody after further investigation had been conducted by the Officers within the 900 block of South Park Avenue. After reviewing the facts of this case with the Lake County States Attorney's Office; Morris was issued a citation for Failure to Notify with Change of Address as a Sexual Offender. Morris was later transported to the Lake County Jail pending a bond hearing.

Warrant Arrest:

On 11/18/2017, an Officer was investigating a property damage traffic accident and made contact with a subject, **Jeffery A. Stauche**, 46, of Waukegan who was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed he had a valid warrant for his arrest from the Lake County Sheriff's Office and Illinois Department of Corrections. Stauche was later transported to the Lake County Jail pending a bond hearing.
